- Cover designs may be submitted up until Saturday, March 3rd.
- All submissions must be original work by the submitter. No copy right infringement please! Any work using copyrighted images will be disqualified.
- Program cover dimensions are 8.5 inches tall by 7 inches wide (the size of the box on this page)
 - You may leave space within the design area for SDPAC staff to overlay text.
 - **OR** you can incorporate the text: Spotlight Dance & Performing Arts Center presents Robin Hood OR Robin Hood presented by Spotlight Dance & Performing Arts Center.
- You may use any medium for your design (pencils, markers, paint, digital programs, etc), but please keep in mind the design must photocopy well (in black or grayscale).
- Designs may be submitted in multi or single color.
- You may co-design a cover with another, just be sure to credit both creators!
- You may submit as many different covers as you like.
- You may use the attached entry form or any other sheet of paper that is larger than 8.5x7 inches (i.e. there must be blank space around the design area to allow for cropping).
- By submitting a design you agree to allow SDPAC full reproduction rights of the image for all marketing and publicity needs.
- The winner of the cover design contest will be acknowledged inside the program.
- Entries will be judged on creativity, quality, and ability to capture the essence of our production.
